

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES OVER 7.5 TONNES) (VARIOUS  
PARISHES) (WESTERN DIVISION) ORDER 1990 (AMENDMENT No. 27) (DISTRICT OF  
NORTHWEST LEICESTERSHIRE AND THE PARISH OF RAVENSTONE WITH  
SNIBSTON) ORDER 202

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(4), 4, 5 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 7.5 tonne gross weight restriction on The Limes, Chapel Close, Coppice Close, Marsden Close, Aspen Close, Claremont Drive, Orchard Close, Thorntree Close, Glebe View, Bloom Close, Formans Way, Berry Close and Pollard Way, Ravenstone and Ashland Drive, Belmont Drive, Dayton Close, Claremont Drive and Fulton Drive, Coalville
2. To revoke a 7.5 tonne gross weight restriction on Coalville Lane and Floret Close, Ravenstone and Western Avenue, Charles Street, Snibston Drive and Ravenstone Road, Coalville
