STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council proposes to make the following order.

Due to on-going residents' concerns regarding HGV'S accessing The Limes (and various roads), it is necessary to implement a 7.5 tonne weight restriction to include all roads within the estate.

The proposal is to remove the weight limit restriction on Coalville Lane/Ravenstone Road so that HGV's can access the industrial estate and not use The Limes estate. If Coalville Lane remained it would not stop HGV's legally using The Limes, as weight limits are in zones they could enter the zone via Belmont Drive and still access the industrial estate without making an offence.

By removing Coalville Lane, the split when between the two roads (Ashby Road and Coalville Lane) will continue for HGV operators to access the industrial estate. HGV's are mistaking Belmont Drive for the route to the industrial estate; which this proposal will address and make it an offence for them to use.
